Responsibilities for ECHO technologist

- Routinely performs high quality transthoracic studies on patients with congenital cardiac pathologies
- Performs clerical duties to include, filing of reports, forwarding reports to physicians' offices
- Performs high quality diagnostic cardiovascular ultrasound procedures
- Certification from an accredited school for Vascular Sonography or equivalent, Documented on-the-job training
- Current adult echo license of RDCS or CCI (required)
- Current vascular license of RVT or CCI (required)
- Assist the Physicians in the delivery of safe, age appropriate patient care during testing in the Echocardiography Lab
- Work collaboratively with the Registered Nurses (RNs) and MDs in a health team forum to promote wellness and optimize patient outcomes and quality care
- Participate in unit / department / institution performance improvement activities that impact patient and service outcomes based on professional practice standards
- Observes sound wave display screen as scanning device moves over patients' body to detect pathologies and to evaluate the hearts wall motion, valve function and so forth

- Current Ultrasound and Vascular Registry
- Minimum two years' experience preferred
- Registered or eligible for credentialing as an Echocardiographer (must obtain registration within 3 months of employment)
- Minimum of 2 years of echocardiogram scanning experience required
