Responsibilities for echocardiographer

- RDMS or RDCS Certification
- Must be a graduate of an accredited Echocardiography school
- Must be ARDMS/RDCS certified
- Two years of echo experience preferred
- Perform echocardiograms tests/procedures in accordance with American Society of Echocardiography standards, performing M-mode, 2D, pulse, continuous wave and color doppler
- Perform various clerical duties to ensure optimal department functioning and proper flow of information and service to physicians for timely test interpretation and patient treatment plans
- Anatomy, both normal and abnormal, must be known and demonstrated as documentation
- Utilize specific echocardiography machines specific transducers to perform echocardiogram
- Performs holter monitor hookup
- Sets up and adjusts all equipment, selects and manually maneuvers transducers to obtain images for physician review

Qualifications for echocardiographer

- One year of imaging experience in the cardiac specialty preferred
- Prefer specific experience and training in cardiac ultrasonography
- ARDMS Certification within 12 months of hire

- Must be a registered technologist in Echocardiography and/or Vascular technology
- Proof of registry (by primary source) must be available within 60 calendar days of graduation
