## Responsibilities for echocardiographer

- Performs bench work, which may include measuring and mounting of echocardiograms, training new personnel to increase skills and knowledge of departmental procedures

- Assumes other responsibilities and duties that relate to patient care as required
- Performs duties as assigned by the Director or Medical Directors
- Keeps equipment clean and in good working order
- Performs routine and transesophageal echocardiograms of high quality on newborn, infant, child, adolescent, adult, and geriatric patients

## Qualifications for echocardiographer

- New hires or incumbents must successfully complete the registry for echocardiography certification within 12 months if not certified at the time of employment
- Requires a degree from an accredited echocardiography/radiology program

- The ability to demonstrate a thorough knowledge an understanding of policies and procedures in performing job duties
- Requires a certificate from an approved echocardiology program
