Responsibilities for ED nurse

- Notifies the bedside RN of the need for emergency support measures (such as cardiopulmonary resuscitation, protecting patient from injury)
- Reports necessary laboratory results, changes in vital signs, cardiac rhythm changes, smart alerts, radiography results, to the bedside RN
- Supervises healthcare assistant and delegates appropriate tasks to be completed in the ED/ICU
- Utilizes hospital information systems to process orders/data and retrieve information
- Focuses on performance improvement initiatives
- Maintains compliance with Core Measures
- Initiates educational opportunities in collaboration with the Nurse Educator for Emergency Services
- Focuses department work flow to meet HealthAlliance Hospital's Three Pillars
- Assumes RN staff responsibilities as needed per resource availability
- Conforms to ED unit specific policies and age specific competencies
