Responsibilities for ED nurse

- Monitors supervision and evaluation of staff job performances
- Develops, implements, and evaluates budget plan and cost control measures
- Will participate in safety surveys, drills and mock codes in conjunction with Safety Committee and security
- Actively participates in or leads training and performance improvement activities
- Utilizes the nursing process in determining the specialty needs of individual patients for successful outpatient management of their clinical conditions when appropriate
- Navigates identified patients to primary and preventive care by assisting patients to obtain a primary care physician and/or enrollment in a chronic disease management clinic to more effectively manage their clinical needs on an ongoing basis
- Intervenes as necessary to provide patient education, assists in coordination of care and monitors identified patients post discharge to assist in overcoming barriers and encourage compliance with follow-up plans
- Documents assessments and interventions in the patient's medical records
- Maintain mental and reasoning capabilities
- Knowledge to identify patient acuity levels

Qualifications for ED nurse

- Must have a license as a Registered Nurse (RN) - State of Oklahoma
- Must have a minimum of an Associate's Degree in Nursing (ADN)

- Must have a minimum of one (1) year of hospital experience - preferably in an ED or Adult ICU
- Must have BLS & ACLS - American Heart Association (AHA)
- Previous clinical expertise within the Emergency Department
