Responsibilities for EHS manager

- Maintain in-depth knowledge of existing and proposed environmental health and safety Federal and Texas, State regulations
 - Compile periodic reports to HQ, work cooperatively with EHS HQ on various projects and initiatives
 - Lead efforts to maintain VPP Star Status at site
 - Provide leadership, support and technical guidance to the Charleroi leadership team, to assure programs are developed and effectively implemented providing safe and healthy working environments for employees in Charleroi & at customer sites
 - Provides guidance in the identification and correction of the root causes of incidents
 - Responsible of Obtaining and Updating Operational Permits before the different Government Offices the Preparation of EH&S reports as required for submission to regulatory authorities
 - Responsible for Selecting, Training, Motivating and Developing the EH&S Staff acting as a Facilitator
 - Follows up the work of EHS Specialists
 - Take a leading role in planning, co-ordinating, monitoring and implementing EHS policies and procedures
