- Familiar with PLC's and able to log onto PLC controlled system (Allen Bradley, Siemens, Mitsubishi)
- Ensure that all documentation associated with activities is documented with Good Documentation Practices
- Maintain an updated and current training record (adhere to training timelines in Compliance Wire)
- Participate in Safety initiatives and other plant designated programs (Zero Defects, OEE)
