Responsibilities for electromechanical technician

- Create and audit preventative maintenance tasks, procedures, and logs, and maintain documentation of downtime and repairs
- Ensure production is in compliance with International Organization for Standardization (ISO) and Food and Drug Administration (FDA) Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP) regulations
- Ability to communicate with team members to identify and understand symptoms of machine problems
- Provide routine and preventative maintenance and troubleshooting to production equipment
- Follow and demonstrate knowledge of plant and process safety rules, safe operating methods and procedures, good housekeeping practices, and food safety procedures
- Ability to weld effectively
- Must be able to work and participate in a dynamic team environment
- Support activities at JPL and the spacecraft launch site
- Ensure that the process, product, and environment comply with Laboratory protocols, government regulations, and professional standards
- Assemble and test electronic hardware in accordance with defined engineering procedures or guidelines under the direction of the engineering team

Qualifications for electromechanical technician

- Assist with PMs
