Responsibilities for embroidery machine operator

- Clean, fold QC, press and bag item
- Using embroidery machine to print onto caps, tote bags, clothing or other similar material

- Responsible daily, per shift, for ensuring proper graphic placement and graphic sew-out as requested on grid sheets and shown on color copies
- Responsible for correct STAR production and accurate recording onto Embroidery paperwork
