Responsibilities for emergency dept

- Collects specimens according to RN's instructions and to the procedure
- Assists patients to and from bathroom
- Positions patients according to RN's instructions (fowler, semi-fowler,) and changes position as frequently as ordered and using good body mechanics
- Assists with stringing IVs under the direction of the Emergency Department nurse
- Be under the general supervision of the Emergency Department Nurse Manager, Assistant Nurse Manager, or Resource Nurse, performs basic emergency medical/trauma procedures and patient care as directed
- The EST demonstrates proficiency in delivering care to assigned age-specific patient population (e.g., infants, adolescents, adults, geriatrics, pediatrics), and participates in related continuing education
- Function as a member of the team through active participation in staff meetings
- Committees, and special projects
- Demonstrate and promote the principles of relationship based care through the development of healthy relationships with patients, staff and physicians
- This is accomplished through the job components of patient services, role modeling, quality/resources stewardship and patient advocacy/customer service

Qualifications for emergency dept

- This position includes being on call via pager and may require working unusual hours
- Demonstrated self-directness
- Previous phlebotomy experience preferred (within the last 3 years)
- Years ICD-9/CPT coding experience in an acute care hospital OR successful completion of an accredited coding program
- Successful completion of ICD-10 CM (and PCS preferred) training
