Responsibilities for environmental health & safety engineer

- Work with the site to insure compliance with state and federal environmental permits and programs
- Work with Corporate ES&H local engineering and operations personnel on authorizations for new or modified sources, permit renewals, and permit modifications
- Initiating and completing activities leading to new or improved EHS processes which have significant impact potential at a program or project level within the assigned area of responsibility
- Participation and leading environmental projects and programs in close cooperation with internal and external stakeholders
- You are part of the EHS team and work on implementation of common EHS programs
- Participate in and conduct audits as required to maintain compliance with ISO 14001
- Engage and educate employees on environmental activities and environmental competency requirements
- Complete and maintain reporting and recordkeeping requirements (i.e., hazardous waste generation, spill prevention, air emissions, source reduction and waste minimization, and storm water permits)
- Lead "Green Committee" environmental initiatives
- Assist the Safety Engineer in training, compliance, communication and other

Qualifications for environmental health & safety engineer

- Perform incident investigations to determine root cause and corrective actions
- Familiarity with international EHS regulation
- ARM/CRM or equivalent certification
- Frequent to constant lifting or exertion of force of up to 35 lbs, occasionally up to 50 lbs effort and infrequent heavy exertion in excess of 50 lbs force
- The employee is constantly or frequently required to stand, walk, reach with arms and hands, frequently to climb or balance, and to stoop, kneel, crouch or crawl
- Vision abilities required by this job include close vision, ability to judge dimensions and spatial relationships
