Responsibilities for environmental health

- Keep up to date with developments in health, safety and environmental legislation and best practice
- Review new product lines and chemicals to determine health hazard potentials, and proper hazardous waste classifications
- Supports internal & third party safety & environmental audits
- Leads, develops or coordinates supervisory, new hire, and contractor training programs which will increase proficiency in safe practices and promote safety & environmental consciousness
- Responsible for serving as a technical resource to support associates, at all levels, on safety and environmental related issues
- Manages the development of programs/events that build awareness, motivate associates to participate in plant safety & environmental initiatives
- Test workplace for environmental hazards such as exposure to radiation, chemical and biological hazards, and excessive noise
- Lead by example, maintaining the highest standards of health and safety ensuring a safe working environment for our employees, contractors and customers
- Provide transformational leadership and coaching on health, safety, environment and energy management to employees on site
- Manages at least 2 full time direct reports

Qualifications for environmental health

- Applied knowledge and working understanding of federal/county safety requirements
- Requires at least eight (8) years' experience in industrial safety or aviation operations management with a strong focus on implementation of safety programs and positive safety culture
- Qualified students must be currently enrolled in a college degree program and have a minimum GPA of 2.75 to be considered
