## Responsibilities for environmental services supervisor

- Regularly surveys departmental procedures for adherence to acceptable cleaning practices
- Experience in environmental services practices required
- Knowledge of infection control and hospital cleaning standards and use of equipment is required
- Maintains and compiles information, such as inventory of equipment and supplies, job status reports, and budget documentation
- Attends staff meetings with agency / institution departmental personnel and make recommendations on new policies and/or procedures
- Perform ice and snow removal
- Empower employees to accomplish the mission of the institution
- Develops and helps implement the project-level environmental management program
- Provides assistance to project and construction management in identifying and complying with project environmental requirements and in addressing environmental issues as they arise during project execution
- Coordinates with and provides technical assistance to other project-assigned functional leads (e.g., engineering, subcontracts, procurement, project controls) with regards to compliance with project-specific environmental requirements

- Working knowledge of basic cleaning equipment/techniques
- Knowledge of the Environmental Service Department

- At least 2 years of experience in housekeeping, EVS, or a similar environment
- Answers promptly to page/phone system and acts accordingly, prioritizing requests according to importance/severity of tasks
