Responsibilities for equipment mechanic

- Disassemble system in to subassemblies
- Determine need for repair or replacement of components by use of wide variety of precision test devices or gages and participate in determining methods or repair
- Perform repairs and modifications to equipment, often complicated by critical tolerances and surface requirements
- Use precision measuring equipment to maintain dimensional accuracy
- Test and troubleshoot assemblies and determine conformance to applicable specifications using a variety of precision measuring devices such as test consoles, flow meters, pressure gages, micrometers and other standard or special purpose equipment
- May perform clerical and material handling tasks that are incidental to the job
- Experience and knowledge of cooler and freezer equipment
- Customer Service, including working well with others
- Must be able to work safe and follow all Federal and State laws and regulations company policies and maintain a clean work environment
- Diagnose, troubleshoot, test, inspect, operate, adjust, repair, lubricate, clean or overhaul mobile mechanical, hydraulic, and pneumatic equipment, such as cranes, bulldozers, graders, front end loaders, haul trucks, face drillers, mechanical scalers, explosives loading equipment, and conveyors used in construction and mining
