Responsibilities for equipment mechanic

- Maintain cleanliness of all mobile equipment including bobcats, front end loaders, forklifts, cranes
- Follow and promote safety culture within the shop
- Perform structural modifications and repairs on crushing equipment
- Examine and repair protective guards, loose bolts, and specified safety devices on equipment and makes adjustments to ensure proper working conditions
- Perform preventative maintenance services such as changing oil and fluids on machinery
- Document repairs using fleet software
- Perform minor electrical repairs on crushing equipment
- Trouble shoot minor electrical and hydraulic repairs on equipment
- Operate sheer machine and scissors lift
- Analyzes malfunctions and repairs, rebuilds, and maintains construction equipment such as trucks, trailers, cranes, paving machines, motor graders, trench digging machines, bulldozers, pumps, compressors and pneumatic tools

- Must be able to drive and operate mobile equipment using levers and pedals to operate
