- Attends and completes all breastfeeding training classes, regular in-service trainings, participates in appropriate WIC Program and Health Department meetings and attends conferences and workshops as assigned
- Counsels WIC pregnant and breastfeeding mothers at scheduled intervals determined by the FDOH Hendry/Glades Counties WIC and Nutrition program through individual support, group classes, and telephone contacts

- Counsels WIC pregnant and breastfeeding mothers by telephone at scheduled intervals determined by the local WIC program

- Receives a caseload of WIC clients and makes routine periodic contacts with all client assigned based on WIC program protocols
