Responsibilities for field technician

- Providing technical assistance in materials engineering and testing related projects and tasks, including carrying out field and laboratory testing of various materials on construction sites, in-situ density testing with a nuclear densometer gauge and testing of concrete and asphalt materials
- Carrying out and supporting field work operations for subsurface investigations including layout, logging boreholes and test pits, site surveying to determine elevations at specific locations, sampling soil and groundwater, and detailed site sketches
- Working with and providing support to other members of the group in assisting with other field, laboratory and office activities as required
- Carrying out laboratory tests on soils, aggregates, concrete and other construction materials to various industry standards
- Handling and disposing of samples weighing up to 50lbs
- General laboratory cleaning and maintenance duties as required
- Oversight of subcontractors performing system maintenance/repair and monitoring
- Shoveling, power washing, cleaning, sweeping
- Decontamination of various structures, machinery, buildings
- IT Support relating to technical issues involving core business applications and operating systems
