Responsibilities for financial markets

- Approve tax risks for new business initiatives / transactions as delegated by the CTO
- Ensure that the each of the business divisions functional layers take advantage of all acceptable tax optimisation opportunities in line with the Group's Tax Risk appetite
- Reconcile accounting results of Global Markets products to control systems, explain and be able to quantify differences between accounting results among various reports
