- Organise the year-end audit process and work with external auditors to resolve issues within the funds
- Prepare consolidated financial statements and Form 10-K and 10-Q filings with the SEC, including footnotes and other required disclosures
- Prepare financial reporting packages and supporting schedules for management and quarterly press releases
- Preparation of the supporting tie-out documentation for external filings
- Creation of monthly cost center level Hyperion financial reports and publishing them to business owners
- Preparation and filing of U.S. Census forms with the Department of Commerce
- Preparation of supporting documentation in compliance with the Company's accounting policies and SOX documentation requirements
- Monthly reconciliation of key accounts and various financial analyses to monitor the accounts of the acquired companies in the post-close integration process (intangibles)
