Responsibilities for flagger

- Accurately distribute tickets (proof of purchase) to each customer
- Adhere to dress code – Must be able to work outside in any weather conditions (rain, snow, wind, heat,) and be able to continuously stand for extended periods of time (3-6 hours)
- Communicate with management, supervisors and traffic directors
- Answer customer service questions concerning parking and the answer general customer inquiries in a courteous, professional and effective manner and refer questions to the supervisor when applicable
- Will be expected to take direction from Managers, Supervisors and emergency responders during emergencies
- The Flagger will perform on-site roadway worker protection supporting for both 3rd-party and railroad activities on and around live railroad tracks
- Responsible for job site coordination, dispatcher/train communication, and various types of On-Track Safety in controlled and non-controlled track
- Perform daily job briefings with all personnel on the job site and ensure all personnel adhere to the safety requirements of the railroad
- Many assignments require walking or standing for extended periods
- Maintain safety credentials and actively participate in routine reoccurring safety classes and qualification training

Qualifications for flagger

- Must be properly trained in flagging techniques, alert, good eyesight, quick

- 1-2 years of experience as a certified flagger
- Previous related experience in the construction field is preferred
- Must be at least 18 years of age due to the nature of working environment
- Must pass a drug screen, physical and criminal background check
- Must display a professional and courteous attitude to co-workers, supervisors, and the general public at all times
