- Primarily oversees food service production for residential dining and catering at this account with close to 400 residents
- Has oversight of up to 30 employees and works side by side with the production employees in the kitchen
- Works with the Executive Chef to develop and grow the menu for the dining area catering while managing and controlling food costs and offering high quality service to the residents and guests
