- May handle cash transactions from customers while maintaining cleanliness of cafe and/or dining area
- Performs a variety of routine tasks in the kitchen, on the tray line, in the dishwashing areas, and in the cafeteria according to standard practices and procedures
- Complies with regulatory requirements
- Processes all phone calls using appropriate telephone skills
- Troubleshoots interface issues with diet orders and resolves
- Adhered to the Service Excellence Standards of Behavior guidelines at all times
