Responsibilities for french teacher

- Minimum of 3 years of progressive experience in teaching French
- Experience in teaching adults, especially in multi-cultural environment is an advantage
- The primary classroom responsibility will be to teach the various levels of Spanish and/or French from novice to post-AP
- The teacher will also be expected to routinely work collaboratively on curriculum development
- Outside of the classroom, the teacher will supervise co-curricular activities
- Provides classroom instruction to students as outlined in lesson plans
- Creates a classroom that is conducive to learning and appropriate to the maturity and interests of students
- Maintains a safe and orderly environment
- Maintains established routine of the school and classroom procedures in which assigned
- Remains at school the entire school day, unless otherwise instructed to leave by building principal
