Responsibilities for functional architect

- Scan, engage, research and analyses the Business domain organizations and generate requirements
- Prepare, articulate, create and clarify Business requirements to Product teams and other stakeholders
- Mentoring and Grooming Business Analysts and SMEs in the team
- Reviews functional design documents, user stories and other functional artifacts to ensure that they are in alignment with the Business need
- Document the logical data model (diagrams + text explanations for main objects)
- Maintain a backlog of open questions on data modelisation coming from all streams (banking, portfolio management , CRM, eBanking)
- Define and document the application architecture including all peripheral systems (GL, Purchase Ledger, MIS, Reg reporting, SWIFT, etc)
- Check functional and data consistency between migration streams / integration streams
- Creates communication links between local teams and central (Paris) Architecture team on data or functional topics whenever necessary
- Help local teams in the design and implementation phase
