- Work with the Americas Lead in finalizing program documents and validating objectives and program follow ups
- Participate in UAT execution and management
- Support development of requirements, response reviews, analysis, and coordination of due diligence sessions for Requests for Proposal (RFP)
- Support Third Party Oversight (TPO) activities and follow up
- Provide program support to work stream leads for the Policy and Process work stream
