Responsibilities for hazardous materials technician

- Segregate waste into hazard classes and package for off-site disposal
- Bar-code chemicals as they are received daily
- Ability to move up to 400 pound drums with drum cart
- Manages hazardous and non-hazardous waste streams for the Atlanta Syrup Plant including concentrates, caustic, and product returns
- Coordinates special waste disposal projects including the handling of infectious materials, asbestos, PCBs, hazardous waste and non-hazardous waste
- Develops and conducts employee training on hazardous waste streams
- Advises management on potential hazardous materials and makes recommendations as required
- Maintains records such as hazardous and non-hazardous waste manifests and associated documents
- Responds to hazardous materials spills such as oil, non-hazardous and hazardous
- Performs other SES related duties as assigned

Qualifications for hazardous materials technician

- Must be able to obtain licenses for the operation of ordnance-handling equipment, including cranes, K-Loaders, forklifts, man-lifts, tractor-trailers

- Must satisfactorily pass and annual physical for handling hazardous and toxic fuels and materials
- Must have computer skills and knowledge in use of Microsoft Word/Outlook
- Ability to travel overnight 30% (1-2 nights/week)
- Years of directly related experience in a full time capacity or equivalent
