Responsibilities for hazardous materials technician

- Manage field notes and prepare technical reports
- Safely collect hazardous and non-hazardous waste, including inspection of waste containers and waste tickets, and correction of any issues found prior to accepting possession of said containers
- Safely collects and transports Regulated Medical Waste from medical center and other collection points to the SMHF
- Under the guidance from the supervisor, performs the logging in, segregation, labeling, bulking and storage of hazardous waste
- Washes reusable containers and labels them for reuse
- Perform emergency response to spills under supervision of Hazardous Waste Supervisor, or Program Manager
- Assists with response to indoor air quality incidents
- Performs general upkeep on SMHF work areas
- Wash reusable materials containers and prepare them for reuse
- Distribute Regulated Medical Materials containers

Qualifications for hazardous materials technician

- High School diploma with coursework in chemistry and biology preferred
- Bachelor's degree including coursework in the basic sciences
- Degree in Chemistry, Environmental Science or like field preferred
- 40 Hour OSHA and DOT certification preferred

- Graduation from high school or a General Education Diploma and four years of experience in an environmental health and safety program, or two years of college including appropriate science courses and three years of experience in an environmental health and safety program
