Responsibilities for hazardous

- Performs daily routine prevention maintenance checks on ATO vehicles and loaders
- Ensures that each ATO vehicle has the proper operating/safety equipment aboard
- Communicates via two-way radio in accordance with proper radio etiquette and procedures
- Ensures that the USAP Cargo staging areas are properly maintained, organized, and kept clean
- Must be capable of regularly lifting 40 pounds (safety regulation maximum)
- Hazardous and medical waste pickups from various customer locations utilizing a box truck
- Ensures proper loading, segregation and unloading of hazardous, non-hazardous and medical wastes
- Assisting the Other Chemists with the execution of assigned labpack projects
- Directly accountable for market strategy development to drive increase adoption of CSTDs, including publication strategy to support and enhance value propositions
- Maintain and update the HDS team on market both internal and external that may affect or influence the product line

Qualifications for hazardous

- Minimum 3 years warehouse experience
- Self-motivated, ability to prioritize and organize efforts and work

- Ability to grasp concepts quickly and reduce them to practice with minimal supervision in a fast-paced environment
- High School Diploma or equivalent required with (3) year of chemical laboratory or waste handling experience
- All moving traffic convictions, both private and commercial, within the previous five years are considered
- No traffic convictions involving driving under the influence, open intoxicants, reckless driving, speeding in excess of 15 mph over posted limit, or conviction of any crime involving the use of a motor vehicle
