## Responsibilities for hazardous waste technician

- May be required to operate tractors and other heavy machinery after training
- Performing physical labor duties
- Additional duties as assigned by the supervisor
- Operating, trouble shooting, and performing preventative & scheduled maintenance for the wastewater treatment system, filter press, probes, filters, pumps, process tanks, sludge removal/disposal, solution replenishment, chemical handling, storage & disposal
- Perform related departmental housekeeping & 5S activities
- Coordinate hazardous & nonhazardous waste from all areas of the facility, including oils, coolants, sealants, oily rags, scrap metals, contractor waste
- Handling of hazardous chemicals
- Material handling using lift truck
- Retrieves hazardous waste (HW) from customer accumulation points (HWAPS)
- Prepares HW containers for closeout by the HW supervisor

## Qualifications for hazardous waste technician

- Provide on-call coverage due to PTO, training, weekend work
- Grade 4 Industrial Wastewater License preferred
- Proficiency in Windows based applications preferred
- 40 Hour Hazwoper (or 8 Hour refresher) required
- Requires the manual lifting of up to 80 pounds
