Responsibilities for hazardous waste technician

- Interact with vendors and suppliers for water treatment and wastewater disposal
- Monitor gauges, meters, and computer displays on equipment to make sure equipment is running correctly, and to monitor amounts of water processed
- Ensure hazardous waste containers are properly labeled and are disposed of within the allotted time
- Coordinate team schedules and provide on-call coverage for training, weekend work
- Oversee process to ensure site inspections, logs, manifest information and reporting are completed as required to submit to regulatory agencies
- Pick-up, delivery, and transportation of Heavy Hazardous Waste Drums to/from designated sites in all weather conditions
- Operate a forklift, gasoline powered pump, pressure washer, and flatbed pickup
- Conduct both visual and documented inspections of all containers at Waste Facility
- Follow directions given by direct supervisor and lead technician
- Wear required personal protective equipment (PPE)
