## Responsibilities for hazardous waste technician

- Assist with the receiving and barcoding of hazardous materials (specifically chemicals and biologicals), includes entering data into the university's central hazardous materials inventory database
- Assist with the distribution of hazardous materials to clients and provide support with storage of these materials, as required
- Assist with the collection of hazardous waste (chemical, radioactive, biomedical) and ensures proper completion of internal hazardous waste disposal documentation
- Assist with the removal of hazardous materials from the university's central hazardous materials inventory database
- Assist with the preparation and delivery of the replacement hazardous waste collection containers with appropriate identification
- Report questionable quantities of hazardous materials, unsafe storage conditions to supervisor
- Assist with the response to hazardous materials spills and assists with postspill clean-up
- Help maintain hazardous materials spill response equipment by conducting regular inventory and inspection of the material, which may include decontamination
- Assist with the maintenance of hazardous waste collection of supplies and equipment
- Operate lifting equipment of various sizes, including drum carts

- Keep an accurate inventory of chemicals in the chemical storage area
- Support waste water operations
- Receive chemical deliveries
- Responsible for other related tasks assigned by the EH&S Department
- Ability to interpret material and equipment standards
