Responsibilities for heavy equipment operator

- Interprets engineering drawings and use of staking and leveling equipment
- May determine grade on which to cut location

- Ability to efficiently operate bulldozers, wheel loaders, motor grader, scraper

## Qualifications for heavy equipment operator

- Must be able to obtain a 5984-E Army Standard license
- Must be able to endure long hours, exposure to weather and hazardous conditions

- High school graduate or equivalent is strongly preferred
