Responsibilities for heavy equipment operator

- Inspects all equipment used on a daily basis
- Proactively protects the well-being of associates and the environment by ensuring a culture of safety awareness and strict compliance of all EHS and Hazmat policies and procedures
- Operation and minor maintenance of various types of heavy equipment including excavator, boom truck, side boom, dozer
- Laboring
- The landfill laborer's main priority is to give clear verbal and non-verbal direction to truck drivers entering the landfill
- Making sure all safety rules and regulations are being followed by all landfill customers
- Candidates must also have the ability to efficiently operate bulldozers, wheel loaders, excavator and off road dump trucks on a as needed basis
- Ability to efficiently operate bulldozers, wheel loaders, motor grader, scraper, forklifts, skidsteers
- Manual labor, paper picking, keeping landfill clean and presentable
- Heavy lifting, moving items from one place to another within the landfill

Qualifications for heavy equipment operator

- Must possess and maintain a valid motor vehicle operator's license and have

- Obtain an Equipment operator's certification for equipment being operated
- Must be willing and able to work as part of a team
- Required to stand, walk and climb for extended periods of time
- Must wear FRC clothing
- While performing the duties of this job the employee is regularly exposed to moving mechanical part, fumes, airborne particles, outside weather conditions and vibration
