Responsibilities for heavy equipment operator

- Operation of various equipment to include but not limited to, Hydro-Excavation Trucks, Track Excavators, Wheel Loaders, Track Dozer, Backhoe, Skid Loader, Mobile Crane, and other equipment required by the conditions of the task assigned
- Participation in emergency call outs
- Operation of Class A and B vehicles

- Inspecting equipment, performing preventative maintenance on equipment, and scheduling major repairs

Qualifications for heavy equipment operator
