Responsibilities for home infusion RN

- Assures departmental understanding, implementation and compliance with all aspects of the company's Performance Improvement Program
 - Able to travel up to two hours each way, on occasion for a patient visit
 - Provide direct nursing services and case management related to infusion therapy for patients in the home, clinic, or alternate living site
 - Accomplish direct nursing goals through collaboration and coordination with various providers, the patient and/or caregiver, the physician and the payor
 - Perform services which are provided in the states of Oregon and Washington (southwest region)
 - Carry a case load of patients and participate in on call as indicated by staffing and business needs
 - May provide education regarding BriovaRx Infusion Services, for both internally and external customers
 - Willing and able to travel up to two hours each way (on occasion) for a patient visit
 - Establish and maintain positive clinical rapport with all patients and their families, representing BriovaRx including working directly with patients and their families, maintain contact and clinically monitor all patients providing direct infusion therapy services
 - Establish and maintain all clinical documentation including Plans of Care / Treatment (POC / POT), Clinical Summaries, medication changes and updates for BriovaRx pharmacy
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- Strong clinical knowledge and skills
- Leadership and management ability and skills
- Minimum two (2) years of experience in medical-surgical in an acute care setting or two (2) - four (4) years of experience in home health or infusion therapy
