Responsibilities for home infusion RN

- May provide education regarding BriovaRx Health Solutions services, for both internally and external customers
- Be able to travel, up to two hours each way (on occasion) for a patient visit
- Be able to work up to three Saturdays a month
- Be able to work between 11am and 7pm
- Make a difference by using your management experience to support field RNs, as they help our patients recover in the comfort of their own home, after they leave the hospital
