Responsibilities for hospital pharmacist

- Acts as the leader of the medication management team by guiding Pharmacy technicians to fulfill the necessary dispensing functions to ensure positive patient outcomes
- Participates in the multidisciplinary team to provide feasible therapeutic recommendations and alternatives that improve patient drug therapy
- Actively participates in department cost savings initiatives
- Provides professional, engaging customer service to all patients, and healthcare providers with whom they work
- Provide oversight and direction regarding all activities and all employees as they relate to the practice of pharmacy while servicing as the Pharmacist on-duty
- Maintenance of security provisions to be used when the pharmacy is closed
- Maintain the recordkeeping system for purchase, sale, delivery, possession, storage, inventory and safekeeping of drugs
- Advise the Coordinator of Pharmacy and Materials Management (Pharmacist-in-charge) on pharmacy issues
- Provide faculty, staff, students, and clients with pharmaceutical information regarding the clinical aspects of the pharmacy
