Responsibilities for ICU RN

- Must be able to lift, push, and pull up to 50 pounds and perform all functions involved in safe patient handling
- Critical Care (ICU, PCU) experience preferred
- Ability to concentrate and pay close attention to detail when performing professional nursing care and dealing with patients and families often under intense situations
- Ability to concentrate and pay close attention to detail when performing professional nursing care dealing
- With patients and families often under tense situations
- Must be proficient in required competencies upon completion of orientation, as listed on the unit specific

Qualifications for ICU RN

- ACLS, PALS, or NRP (or obtained within six months of employment) in required specialty
- BLS and ACLS Provider credentialed from the American Heart Association (AHA) obtained prior to hire date or job transfer date
- 1 -2 years of ICU, ED or PACU experience required
- BLS Provider credentialed from the American Heart Association (AHA) obtained prior to hire date
- Previous experience in Critical Care Units
- ACLS within 6 months of start date and must maintain recognition
