## Responsibilities for imaging technician

- Uses time between procedures to clean equipment and rooms, and to stock supplies
- Interacts with patients, visitors, physicians and co-workers in a manner that ensures patient rights and confidentiality at all times
- Demonstrates flexibility with work schedule changes
- Assist with rush orders
- Maintain cleanliness and organization of assigned work area and department

- Of technical staff, management of the patient flow and managing staffing levels
- Maintain the equipment and supporting experiments using the MicroCT and other imaging devices
- Support maintenance of the MicroCT imaging system working with the vendor

## Qualifications for imaging technician

- Scans documents according to policies and procedures on an "as-needed" basis, as directed by departmental processes, the HIM Document Imaging Manager, or their designee
- Assists with the boxing of scanned documents according to established procedures

- To perform this job successfully, an individual should possess the knowledge, skills, and abilities listed and meet the amount of education, training, and/or work experience required
- One year of experience as a Biomedical Electronics Technician II OR Five years of experience as a biomedical electronics technician OR equivalent education/experience
- Associate's degree in electronics or biomedical equipment technology is highly desirable, minimum of five years' related experience in the repair and maintenance of medical equipment
