Responsibilities for imaging technician

- Assist hospital staff in the execution of their duties by acting as a resource person for timely, effective use of services, both in electronic and manual modalities
- Meets with the HSC courier to receive and account for all boxes delivered
Unpacks all boxes, and sorts and measures the medical record according to established procedures
- Apply prescribing ionizing radiation for diagnostic imaging examinations
- Assume responsibility for designated areas or procedures as described or required
- Overseeing team of Diamond Imaging Technicians in producing digital images of loose diamonds and ensuring the images produced are within the established standards
- Use advanced photography machines to photograph diamonds from 360 degrees and produce a result that is precise, sharp, and true to life, without obscuring the flaws and by displaying the exact color
- Collaborate with the R2 Net team for quality control and work direction
- Cleaning of loose diamonds using alcohol solvents and other equipment
- Tracking and security of loose diamonds to ensure product integrity
- Upkeep of photography machines and tidiness of photography area
