Responsibilities for imaging technologist

- Act as patient educator prior to catheterization to explain procedure and answer questions
- Correlate and prioritize workload and is flexible when there are interruptions and distractions in order to provide quality services
- Wear radiation safety monitoring equipment in order to record professional exposure and comply with regulatory agency
- Maintain an exceptional attendance record in order to provide appropriate staffing levels
- Explain procedure to patient and acquire clinical history
- Be responsible for ensuring consent forms, questionnaires are filled out completely and entered into EMR
- Position and immobilize patient on x-ray table using supportive devices to obtain precise patient position and following exam protocols specified by Radiologist
- Administer contrast media orally as directed by the radiologist
- Monitor patient's safety and comfort during exam
- Processes images for reading and archiving

Qualifications for imaging technologist

- Years of experience in the specific modality for which the candidate is being considered
- Modality specific advanced level registry must be obtained within twelve months of hire date

three month extension may be considered and granted at the discretion of the management

- Should have or develop expertise in multiple (more than one modalities)of Radiology(X-Ray, OR, CT, NM, Specials, US)
- Must be available to take call and arrive at the hospital with a 30-minute response time
- Modality specific advance level registry must be obtained within twelve months of hire date
