Responsibilities for improvement analyst

- Prepare detailed analysis on targeted KPIs
- Listen to calls and review case history to research issues and create a chronology/summary of the merchant's experience
- Pull a single case or call to validate a merchant claim or research how it was handled by the agent
- Run reports from the system
- Review cases that meet certain criteria to document findings
- Implements improvements initiatives to reduce manufacturing operating costs
- Develops and communicates metrics, event objectives, project status, barriers, and results
- Facilitates kaizen events and leads kaizen teams
- Forecasts financial impact of process improvements
- Investigates problems and requirements to develop and implement appropriate solutions

Qualifications for improvement analyst

- Provide guidance to infrastructure development related to operational tools/process related to provider GIC development tools, supplemental data intake and processing, and analytics (reporting-internal [e.g
- Documentation into SharePoint tool

- Collaborate with team on initiatives to improve clinical results around first QRS identified measures and ultimately around commercial measures that drive accreditation activities

- With the Value Stream Manager, support the identification of production requirements within the Value Stream ensuring alignment with process departments (molding, stamping, plating,) on needed capacity and priorities to achieve the Value Stream goals along with the development and deployment of appropriate planning, replenishment and signaling tools and methodologies aligned with PFEP
