Responsibilities for industrial electrician

- Perform mechanical repairs as needed to plant equipment such as valves, gearboxes, motors, and pumps
- Inspect electrical equipment and machinery, diagnose faulty operation
- Responsible for operating, changing over, setting up, troubleshooting, repairing and improving high speed food manufacturing equipment in addition to providing support for facility infrastructure support equipment
- Maintain root cause analysis shift logs
- Responsible for calibrating and checking production equipment
- Respond in a timely manner to production equipment downtime
- Perform routine maintenance on production equipment and perform necessary repairs
- Read and understand electrical prints
- Program and install VFD's
- Strong working knowledge of industrial servo drives

- Must be flexible to work a 12-hour rotating 2-2-3 shift
- Must hold a Journeyman classification in the trade as an electrician OR have served a bona fide apprenticeship under standards acceptable to the UAW and has a certificate to substantiate such services OR have eight years of practical experience and can prove same with proper affidavits or work records

- Experience in some fabrication, machining, welding, forklift maintenance, auto/diesel mechanic, electrical, plumbing, HVAC
