Responsibilities for industrial maintenance mechanic

- Troubleshooting and repair of electrical and mechanical controls including PLCs, 3 phase and single phase circuits
- Calibrates and repairs electrical mechanical equipment
- Trouble shoot electrical and mechanical production/packaging machines chemical manufacturing
- Performs electrical, electronic, mechanical, hydraulic, and pneumatic maintenance and repair of machinery and equipment
- Assists in special projects such as installation and engineering upgrades
- Maintains and promotes a safe and professional work environment
- Carryout all duties that are necessary for maintaining equipment and machinery in good working order
- Perform and maintain records of scheduled preventative maintenance on plant equipment
- Ensure maximum safety of all workers under their supervision by ensuring that they observe all OSHA and VP Racing safety policies and procedures, and report conditions that are likely to endanger safety of workers to management for quick resolution
- May obtain estimates for supplies, repair parts and orders parts as needed

Qualifications for industrial maintenance mechanic
