Responsibilities for industrial painter

- Exercise care to prevent runs, lags, dry spray and dirt
- Sandblast parts in cabinet type table blast
- Use portable and stand abrasive belt grinders, portable disc grinders and buffing wheels to snag, grind and polish parts
- Assemble sections of machines such as feed end, flexo, die cutter, slotter-creaser and the various combinations thereof as indicated by customer specifications
- Assemble gear trains and idler gears, check and make necessary adjustments to obtain proper backlash
- Assemble bearings in gears and on studs
- Mount open and closing motors, fountain and main drive motors
- Paint small items and apply touch ups using touch up guns
- Clean and maintain painting and coating, ventilation, compressed air and personal protective equipment
- May prepare and apply stencils, computer-generated decals or other decorative items on finished products

Qualifications for industrial painter

- Demonstrates team building, leadership and mentoring skills
- Trained in tank entry permits (confined space training)
- Knowledge of general paint preparation

- Regularly exposed to fumes or airborne particles of toxic or caustic chemicals with air mask provided
