Responsibilities for information systems manager

- Serve as the primary point of contact for all information technology systems and security functions between the company and customer the site and corporate support
- Leads audits or significant components of audits, including core data center infrastructure, application, and project audits
- Designs and executes internal control testing for audits, demonstrating a degree of audit expertise consistent with experience level
- Supervises and coordinates work assignments amongst audit team members
- Establishes and maintains good auditee relations during engagements
- On audit engagements, facilitates teamwork, coordinates and leverages available resources to complete engagements on time
- Work with the resource management teams to develop and manage the resource supply plan for the business
- Help implement Information System Security Plans and Protection Profiles
- Ownership, delivery and documentation of functional requirements and specifications by applying experience and understanding of enterprise application integration, object-oriented design and use case modeling
- Liaise between all levels of cross-functional team to ensure a quality solution that delivers business results (team members cover multiple-disciplines in multiple environments, sometimes outside of North America.)
