Responsibilities for integration consultant

- Serve as a business line expert and provides management consultation to senior leadership matrixed teams for Provider Integration programs, strategy development, product and benefit development, care management

- Represents IT in regular management meetings
- Develops integrator sales leads within the assigned territory through the use of cold calling, referrals, and contact with local customers
