



Example of Interventional Radiology Nurse Job Description

Responsibilities for interventional radiology nurse

- The nurse's purpose is to assist and support the patient so that imaging procedures can be performed in a safe and efficient manner
- To accomplish this, the Interventional Radiology Nurse is required to assist in all aspects of the procedure except for the use of radiation producing equipment
- The Interventional Radiology Supervisor is responsible for providing the nurse with appropriate orientation and training in the radiation safety aspects of the imaging equipment they must work with
- The Interventional Radiology Nurse is also responsible for the maintenance and security of the Department's medication supply, monitoring of patients receiving conscious sedation, and keeping appropriate medical records relating to patient care
- The Interventional Radiology Nurse will provide all imaging personnel with in-service education and training relating to patient care and patient care devices
- The Interventional Radiology Nurse will actively communicate with physicians, nursing units, and family members concerning the patient's well-being, exam status and care, and will perform appropriate patient teaching as needed
- The Interventional Radiology Nurse will actively communicate, cooperate with, and assist other nurses
- The Interventional Radiology Nurse's patient care skills are subject to the

- Provide clinical support to staff members, and assist with management of a caseload of patients being prepared for Interventional Radiology Procedures
- Perform patient assessment, offer patient and family education, pre and post procedure coordination of care interventions and symptom management

Qualifications for interventional radiology nurse

- Knowledge of all types of modalities necessary for the patient's care and well-being, and the skill in recording nursing/medical assessment findings accurately and completely
- Experience in treating patients in the field of vascular and interventional radiology
- One (1) year of experience in a IR or Critical Care, preferred
- A minimum of 3-5 years of clinical experience
- Min 2 years experience as a licensed RN on a Telemetry, ICU, or Emergency Unit
- 2 years of recent adult ICU nursing (RN) experience
