- Design graphical user interfaces (UI) for JMA R&D custom applications
- Color-correct and edit images, graphics and video in consultation with subject matter experts
- Develop photographic assets in consultation with JMA subject specialists
- Develop PowerPoint presentations based on approved templates and content including images, text, animations and video
- Serve as department expert on applying GIA branding to all learning assets
- Research and suggest technological resources that would benefit JMA programs and courses
- Works closely with Team Leaders and Coordinators to meet project objectives in conceptualization and development of illustrations, typography and layouts
- Creates designs with strong artistic sensibilities that satisfy the needs of the traditional and trendy jewelry customers
