Responsibilities for lab specialist

- HTST operation
- Work with the IT Account Managers and local business representatives to get the best implementation of computerized laboratory systems
- Act as a subject matter expert on implementing and using the available IT platform solutions to the benefit of our R&D labs
- Partner with internal and external IT organizations to ensure the delivery of Lab Computing solutions and services needed
- Ensure IT requirements in relation to validation and required documentation are met
- Pro-actively advise and implement improvements to the lab IT architecture (ensure backups, remote platform updates)
- Support business departments with Lab Computing implementations and validation
- Support business departments with maintaining the laboratory systems, excluding the actual device (= Laboratory Computing Help Desk)
- Support the Lab Computing Lead in training other Lab Computing Specialists
- Support non-local business departments as Laboratory Computer Help Desk when required

Qualifications for lab specialist

- Requires the equivalent of a B.S

- Individual must be collaborative, flexible, innovative, and able to work in a dynamic environment
- Understanding of PHY and MAC network concepts is required, software defined radio experience is a bonus
- Existing experience with IoT platforms and LPWAN technologies is a major plus
